Around 1950, no valid explanation was available of the colours of compounds of the five transition groups. Later, it was possible to identify the excited levels with those expected for an electron configuration with a definite number of electrons in the partly filled shell. It is not generally recognized that this is equivalent to determining spectroscopic oxidation states related to the preponderant electron configuration and not to estimates of the fractional atomic charges.
