Indeed, Sheffer shows that the physical border between East and West was not simply imposed by Cold War superpowers, but was in some part an improvised outgrowth of an anxious postwar society. Ultimately, a wall of the mind shaped the wall on the ground. East and West Germans became part of, and helped perpetuate, the barriers that divided them. From the end of World War II through two decades of reunification, Sheffer traces divisions at [Burned Bridge](#) with sharp insight and compassion, presenting a stunning portrait of the Cold War on a human scale.

The communist dictatorship, however, had sought to confront environmental issues since at least the 1960s.
