Es desde la condición de periodista comprometido como se explica este libro, un segundo paso más que sigue a lo que fue la primera edición, con nuevos datos y crónicas recuperadas junto a la demanda de lo que todavía sigue esperando respuestas”, escribe Miguel Ángel Blanco en el prólogo de esta obra. Los hechos conocidos como el caso Almería ocurrieron entre los días 9 y 10 de mayo de 1981, tres meses después del golpe del 23-F. Los cuerpos de Luis Montero, Luis Cobo Mier y Juan Mañas Morales fueron encontrados calcinados en el fondo del barranco de Gérgal. Habían sido confundidos con tres peligrosos etarras, aunque horas antes ya se había aclarado que no eran éstos los terroristas buscados. El 28 de julio de 1982, la Audiencia Provincial de Almería condena a los tres agentes "por ser criminalmente responsables de tres delitos de homicidio". Las familias de las víctimas reclaman, 30 años después, que el caso sea contemplado como terrorismo de Estado. “Porque, aunque se dio como homicidio con atenuante, yo siempre luché por los asesinatos y sigue siendo técnicamente un asesinato”, mantiene Darío Fernández, abogado de la acusación. Cuando se publicó la primera edición de ese libro de investigación, aún no se había celebrado el juicio. Hay nuevos datos que revelan que los tres jóvenes fueron torturados y quemados. El ex teniente coronel Castillo Quero (ya fallecido), el ex teniente Gómez Torres, y el ex guardia Fernández Llamas recibieron tratos de favor en la cárcel y no tardaron en salir en libertad. A la altura de 2011, periodistas de Almería, que vivieron aquellos hechos, “exigen la verdad a la Guardia Civil”. Esta institución, que presta en nuestro tiempo tantos servicios de protección a la ciudadanía, debe aclarar este triple crimen. En algún un momento, la conciencia colectiva de la

Guardia Civil, podrá decidir contar la verdad. Mientras tanto, el caso Almería permanecerá abierto para la historia.

**Right of Way** Dec 31 2019 The face of the pedestrian safety crisis looks a lot like Ignacio Duarte-Rodriguez. The 77-year old grandfather was struck in a hit-and-run crash while trying to cross a high-speed, six-lane road without crosswalks near his son's home in Phoenix, Arizona. He was one of the more than 6,000 people killed while walking in America in 2018. In the last ten years, there has been a 50 percent increase in pedestrian deaths. The tragedy of traffic violence has barely registered with the media and wider culture. Disproportionately the victims are like Duarte-Rodriguez—immigrants, the poor, and people of color. They have largely been blamed and forgotten. In *Right of Way*, journalist Angie Schmitt shows us that deaths like Duarte-Rodriguez's are not unavoidable "accidents." They don't happen because of jaywalking or distracted walking. They are predictable, occurring in stark geographic patterns that tell a story about systemic inequality. These deaths are the forgotten faces of an increasingly urgent public-health crisis that we have the tools, but not the will, to solve. Schmitt examines the possible causes of the increase in pedestrian deaths as well as programs and movements that are beginning to respond to the epidemic. Her investigation unveils why pedestrians are dying—and she demands action. *Right of Way* is a call to reframe the problem, acknowledge the role of racism and classism in the public response to these deaths, and energize advocacy around road safety. Ultimately, Schmitt argues that we need improvements in infrastructure and changes to policy to save lives. *Right of Way* unveils a crisis that is rooted in both inequality and the undeterred reign of the automobile in our cities. It challenges us to imagine and demand safer and more equitable cities, where no one is expendable.
