This 'combination' manual includes alternator and generator testing and servicing instructions, spare parts illustrations and part numbers plus Technical Data Sheets and Service Bulletins that provide additional information due to model updates and/or electronic equipment modifications. It also includes wiring diagrams by individual model type including: A.J.S., Ariel, B.S.A., Dayton, Dunkley, Excelsior, Francis-Barnett, James, Matchless, Norton, Piatti, Raleigh (mopeds) and Triumph.
