The first is the problem that the prosecution of a partnership may be frustrated by dissolution. The second issue concerns the circumstances in which partners might be held criminally liable, as individuals, for offences committed by the partnership. The third is what effect, if any, the dissolution of the partnership may (or should) have upon the prosecution of partners in respect of any such individual liability. Chapter 2 considers the decision of the High Court in *Balmer v HM Advocate*, the case which identified the dissolution problem. Chapter 3 examines the existing law in relation to the prosecution of partnerships, considering both the general rules applying by virtue of the 1890 Act and the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995 and the variety of particular rules established by various offence-creating statutes. Chapter 4 looks at the options for reform. The Commission concludes that dissolution of the partnership is unlikely to be a bar to the enforcement of any individual criminal liability which might have arisen, and that any remaining uncertainty would be removed by resolution of the dissolution issue. Chapter 5 considers the dissolution issue in detail.
