The book ends with a brief treatment of rival positions, including utilitarianism and libertarianism, and of conscience as our ultimate moral guide. Written as an introductory text for students of ethics and natural law, *Morality and the Human Goods* makes arguments consistent with Catholic teaching but is not based on theological considerations.
