Efforts towards dealing with these challenges will require attention to the political-economic climate of the country. To make the argument, the author covers a wide range of topics such as training and learning, technology, productivity, latecomer development, competitiveness, labour market, MSMEs, entrepreneurship, value chains, cooperation and trust, and human resource management. **Protection, Patronage, or Plunder? British Machinations and (B)uganda's Struggle for Independence** Dec 01 2019 In the scramble for Africa, Britain took a lion's share of the continent.
