Discussion Paper on Criminal Liability of Partnerships Aug 05 2020 The law of partnership still needs general reform and modernisation. The present law, based upon the common law and partly codified by a 19th century statute, the Partnership Act 1890, is full of uncertainties and anomalies. This report is concerned with three issues. The first is the problem that the prosecution of a partnership may be frustrated by dissolution. The second issue concerns the circumstances in which partners might be held criminally liable, as individuals, for offences committed by the partnership. The Commission concludes that dissolution of the partnership is unlikely to be a bar to the enforcement of any individual criminal liability which might have arisen, and that any remaining uncertainty would be removed by resolution of the dissolution issue. Chapter 5 considers the dissolution issue in detail.
