Organic farming advocates continued to spread their anti-chemical farming message through a small community that deeply influenced Rachel Carson in Silent Spring, a book that helped to legitimize anti-chemical concerns. The organic farming movement re-entered the scientific mainstream in the 1980s through the reluctant backing of government policy. It has continued to grow in popularity ever since and explains why organic farming continues to inspire those who seek to change agriculture and health.
