The Art of the Short Fiction Film Nov 25 2019 This work is the first of its kind to single out individual short fiction films for comprehensive presentation and close study. The book also describes a new conceptual model, derived from the films studied in the work, which can be used both for analyzing the ways in which a short fiction film tells its story and as a set of guidelines for student filmmakers writing their own screenplays.
