Who Says You Can't Be Perfect? Oct 04 2022 "Sometimes we don't believe we can do what God tells us to do or be what God commands us to be simply because we don't understand what He wants. That's what happens for many Christians when they hear that famous command, "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect." Right away we fall back to our personal human interpretation and decide that "perfect" isn't really what Jesus meant, because "perfect" represents to us a level and a quality that is way beyond our reach. Then we start

When has God ever commanded us to do something or be something and not made the way for us to do that and be that? Has He not given the tools and the ministries to help us do that? Do we not have the presence of God, the leadership, teaching, and example of Jesus, the guidance of His Word, and the power of the Holy Spirit to do what God the Father through Jesus has commanded us to do? If God has given us all that and made it possible for us to honor His command and be perfect as He is perfect, who is qualified to say we can't do it?"

Who Says Women Can't Be Doctors? Apr 29 2022 In the 1830s, when a brave and curious girl named Elizabeth Blackwell was growing up, women were supposed to be wives and mothers. Some women could be teachers or seamstresses, but career options were few. Certainly no women were doctors.
